

ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 5-111 (a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, RE-LETTERING SUBSECTION (b) as (a) and (c) as (b), SAID REPEALER THEN ALLOWING THE USE OF PVC AS PROVIDED IN THE APPLICABLE PLUMBING CODE; PROVIDING THAT THE PASSAGE OF SAID ORDINANCE IS AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, it is necessary that this Ordinance be passed for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the City and its inhabitants,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5-111(a), Code of Ordinance of Port St. Joe, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 5-111(b) of the Code of Ordinances of Port St. Joe is hereby lettered (a).

Section 3. Section 5-111(c) of the Code of Ordinances of Port St. Joe is hereby lettered (b).

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on May 4, 1982.

This Ordinance INTRODUCED and ADOPTED as an emergency ordinance this 4th day of May, 1982.
