

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND ABANDONING A CERTAIN ALLEYWAY IN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, AND AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF SAME TO THE ABUTTING LAND OWNERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the following described alleyway in the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, be, and the same is hereby, vacated, abandoned, discontinued and closed as an alleyway in said City, to-wit:

That certain alleyway twenty feet (20') in width lying between Lots Fifteen(15), Seventeen (17), Nineteen (19), Twenty-one (21), Twenty-three (23) and Twenty-five (25), and Fractional Lot Sixteen (16), being a triangular tract or parcel of land, all in Block Twenty (20) of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida,

for the reason that said alleyway serves no useful purpose for said City.

SECTION 2. That the property located in the alleyway hereby vacated and abandoned be reverted back to the abutting owners of the adjacent lots upon said alleyway; and that the Mayor-Commissioner and City Auditor and Clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized to execute a conveyance of said property located in the alleyway to the abutting land owners, being John G. Blount and Charles F. Johnson.

SECTION 3. That the City of Port St. Joe shall reserve in any conveyance the right of an easement along said alleyway to lay, construct and maintain or authorize a utility company to lay, construct and maintain its utility lines in said alleyway.
