

ORDINANCE NO.: 364

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT REFERENDUM ON AMENDING SECTION 6-1(A) OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ALLOW THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE ON SUNDAY; PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM DATE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the sale of alcoholic beverages within the City limits is currently prohibited; and

WHEREAS, the question of whether to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages within the city limits on Sunday affects the interests of the City's business, religious, and residential communities, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe desires the input of the City's electorate on this issue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the People of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida:

1. The following questions shall be placed before the electors of the City of Port St. Joe:

Do you favor changing Section 6-1(a) of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Port St. Joe to allow, within the city limits, the sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverage in any place holding a license under the State Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 12 midnight on Sundays?

2. Referendum Date: This referendum shall be held on the 2nd Tuesday in May, 2007, at the general election.

3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effectively immediately upon passage.
