#### Disaster Recovery Community Development Block Grant

- The special appropriation provides funds to the most impacted and distressed areas for:
- Disaster Relief.
- Long Term-Recovery.
- Restoration of Infrastructure.
- Housing.
- Economic Revitalization.

### Port St. Joe proposes two CDBG-DR projects:

- Fire and Police Station
- •\$6,925,962
- Sewer Rehabilitation (Lift Station and Collection Lines)
- •\$9,996,000

### Fire and Police Station

- Need: During Hurricane Michael, the current building was inundated with flood waters from storm surge.
- Solution: Construct a facility that will protect occupants, critical equipment and supplies during a disaster event.
- City purchased 5.21 acres on Avenue A to relocate the public safety facilities.
- The facility will be designed to house the fire and police departments.

## Sewer Rehabilitation - Lift Station

- Need: The 20<sup>th</sup> Street Lift Station was damaged by storm surge damaging residue and debris from Hurricane Michael, which flooded equipment and left
- Solution: Repair Lift Station

# Sewer Rehabilitation – Collection Lines

- Need: The 80-year-old sewer collection system, consisting of storm surge from Hurricane Michael. vitrified clay pipe and brick manholes, was severely damaged by
- Solution: Replace Gravity Sewer collection lines and manholes with resilient materials
