He is also concerned about long trucks obstructing driving on Reid Avenue. Mayor Buzzett referenced the new parking ordinance and that it is being enforced.

Neither Mayor Buzzett nor Commissioner Lowry had any additional concerns to share.

Commissioner Hoffman questioned the requirements for the frequency of meetings. City Staff will research this issue.

Chairman Langston asked about additional Christmas lights for MLK Blvd. Mr. Anderson noted the lack of power to several poles and that lighted decorations run around \$2,000 per piece. He and Mr. Anderson will look at the area together.
