Bids will be received by the <u>City of Port St. Joe</u> (herein called the "Owner"), at 305 Cecil G. Costin Sr. Blvd., Port St. Joe, Florida 32456 until <u>3:00 p.m. Eastern</u> Standard Time, <u>September 26, 2025</u>, then opened and read publicly at <u>3:05 p.m. EST</u>.

Each bidder is to submit the cost associated with the removal and installation of a membrane roof for the City Commission Chambers located at 2775 Garrison Avenue Port St. Joe, Florida 32456. Permits will be required for this project and all Bidders shall be licensed in the State of Florida to perform any and all work associated with this Project, including any sub-contractors.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to <u>City of Port St. Joe City Hall, 305 Cecil G.</u>
<u>Costin Sr. Blvd., Port St. Joe, Florida 32456</u>. Each sealed envelope containing a BID must be clearly marked on the outside as BID for <u>CITY OF PORT ST. JOE – RFP 2025-07 City Commission Chambers Roof</u> and the envelope should bear on the outside the BIDDER'S name and address. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the BID must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to the OWNER and properly marked.

All BIDS must describe the work in detail along with the warranty period and include a copy of the bidder's license and liability insurance. Bidder shall submit two copies of the bid in the submittal.

The OWNER may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all BIDS. Any BID may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of BIDS or authorized postponement thereof. Any BID received after the time and date specified shall not be considered, no exceptions. No BIDDER may withdraw a BID within 60 days after the actual date of opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and the BIDDER.

BIDDERS shall review the site and satisfy themselves with the proposed work. After BIDS have been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was misunderstanding concerning the quantities of WORK or of the nature of the WORK to be done.

The OWNER may make such investigations as deemed necessary to determine the ability of each BIDDER to perform the WORK, and the BIDDER shall furnish to the OWNER all such information and data for this purpose as the OWNER may request. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any BID if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such BIDDER fails to satisfy the OWNER that such BIDDER is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the AGREEMENT and to complete the WORK contemplated therein.

A conditional BID will not be accepted.

Award will be made to the most qualified responsible Base BIDDER, whole or in part, as determined by the OWNER. Bids will be evaluated on cost, product quality, maintenance requirements, product delivery time, warranty, and customer service.

All applicable laws, ordinances and rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over this BID shall apply to the contract throughout.
