WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Joe continues to explore funding opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Joe is committed to complying with Florida law, the City of Port St. Joe's Comprehensive Plan, and the City of Port St. Joe's Land Development Regulations; and

WHEREAS, development of the Tenth Street Park will not begin unless in compliance with Florida law; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City of Port St. Joe, THAT: they continue to explore the idea of renovating the Tenth Street Park through State and local funding; continue to explore funding opportunities; and remain committed to complying with Florida law, the City of Port St. Joe's Comprehensive Plan, and the City of Port St. Joe's Land Development and Regulations regarding its development.
